



6 out of 10 people have ongoing need for food assistance

54% of participants receive food weekly or more often, usually nonperishables and produce







Low wages is the 43.2% most common reason for needing assistance

AET has improved access to food through:


- directly providing healthy food to the community (60%)
- increasing access to home delivery or pickup (37%)
- providing farmers market vouchers (24%)
- increasing access using flexible hours and weekend distributions (22% & 18%)

Emerging and continuous need

72% of participants did not receive food assistance prior to AET

Of participants with prior food assistance, 42% receive assistance from Athens Eats Together and other benefits.
