

## **Common Barriers to Food Security<sup>3</sup>**



In 2019, AWP found that 33% of eligible residents in Athens do not participate in SNAP. ACC forgoes \$20 million annually in federal food assistance.



Long wait times to register for SNAP in Athens compared to other counties.

9% of respondents use the ACC bus to get groceries.

Individuals' food access problem is feeling priced out of the market for quality fresh produce.

14% of respondents use ridesharing apps to get groceries.
